Announcing an Eruption Warning Level 2, Volcanic Crater Area Restricted for Mt. Ohachi of the Kirishima Mountains

The Eruption Warning Level has been Raised from Level 1 to Eruption Warning Level 2>

Earthquakes at Mt. Ohachi from volcanic activity have increased. In response to this activity, the Eruption Warning Level has been raise from Level 1 (Caution against the Mountain Being an Active Volcano) to Level 2 (Volcanic Crater Area Restricted).

There is a possibility of a small-scale eruption occurring. Beware of large rocks or other materials ejected from a volcanic eruption within an approximate **1km** of the volcanic crater. **Entering the area leading towards Mt. Takachihonomine is prohibited until further notice.**
